PAB 200+ CLUB RULES

1. The Club will be known as “The PAB 200+ Club” (The Club) is registered at Centre 68, Westgate, Peterborough PE1 1RG. The first draw will take place on 12th December at the Coffee Morning
2. Participation in the 200+ club is open to all PAB members and supporters.
3. The 200+ club is formed for fund raising purposes and all proceeds raised, after provisions of prizes and expenses, will be deposited in funds of Peterborough Association for the Blind.
4. A draw will be held in the presence of three persons and the prizes for ten months will be:
1st £50 2nd £30 3rd £20
Each 6 months. In December and June a one off £100 draw will take place.
All prizewinners will be notified and details announced in the Talking Newspaper and the PAB Newsletter.
5. Application for participation in the 200+ Club must be made to the Honorary Treasurer, Peterborough Association for the Blind. The subscription shall be £12 per share per annum, payable in advance.
6. All monies to be paid in full before entry in the first draw is made.
7. The shares can be held singly or in multiples. Every share must be registered in a single name.
8. Each participant will receive a copy of these rules and a registered number for each share held.
9. New members can join at any time during the year on payment of £12 and will be included in the draw for that month and the remaining 11 months of that year.
10. A register of Club members will be maintained by the Promoter showing members names, addresses, membership numbers, subscriptions received and prizes paid.
11. The Club 200+ entries and payments are shown on the PAB detailed Account. The Account is audited annually by a qualified accountant.
12. The decision of the Executive Committee of the Association is final in any matter requiring adjudication. The committee has the power to amend or revoke these rules after twenty-eight days notice has been given to all members.
13. The promoter or his nominated agent will be responsible for the day to day running of the club to the Executive Committee of Peterborough Association for the Blind.
